

Clinical Trials BC Symposium 2023 FAQs

1. What are the options for attending the symposium?

You can join us for the Symposium in three ways: in person, virtually, or at a group attendance location.

- In-person attendees would be at the venue of Jack Poole Hall located in the Robert H. Lee Alumni Centre at UBC. There will be a cold breakfast, lunch, snacks and beverages provided throughout the day.
- Virtual attendees would watch the symposium from a Zoom link that will be distributed closer to the day of the symposium. If you do not receive the link, please check your spam inbox and then email us at <u>rsahni@healthresearchbc.ca</u>.
- Group attendance attendees would watch the symposium at a designated group attendance viewing hub hosted by Northern Health, Interior Health and Vancouver Island Health. If you choose to attend at a group attendance hub, please choose the one geographically closest to you.

2. Will I receive a certificate of attendance for CEUs?

We will be administering certificates for continuing education credits after the event. Please allow 1-2 weeks to receive your certificate via the email address used to register for the event.

5. Can I attend a group attendance viewing if I don't have a group attendance ticket?
